NSS unit of Digboi College reaches out to forest dwellers

DIBRUGARH, Jan 2: The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Digboi College conducted the second phase of their week-long NSS Special Camp at a remote village known as Saraipung forest village under Digboi Forest Division, which is about 23 kms away from Digboi town, a press release stated.

This village is surrounded by Saraipung Reserve Forest on all sides and is on the edge of the Dehing Patkai Wildlife Sanctuary. Saraipung forest village was established in 1950 by the Forest Department and the present number of households is 86 with 750 individuals, including 300 schoolchildren.

In the special camp, the NSS unit organised several socio-educational awareness programmes in the village from December 26 to 31. Events

like school education programme, free veterinary camp with medicines, free medical camp with medicines, free distribution of mushroom seeds and techniques of cultivation, awareness related to health and hygiene and Swachh Bharat Abhiyan, general cleanliness drive, anti-superstition and anti-witchcraft practices, wildlife conservation and causes of global warming, besides cultural exchange programme by the NSS student volunteers of the college and the villagers were organised. A friendly football match was also held.

A team of 25 student volunteers, including eight female students of NSS Digboi College unit with two teacher-in-charge Rajib Rudra Tariat and Kishor Haloi took active part in the programme.

Dr Dip Saikia, Principal of Digboi College inaugurated the programme in the presence of Pur-

nakanth Upadahya, Headmaster of Saraipung LP School, Sanjivani Bhumij, local Gaonburha and several others. Dr Dip Saikia spoke on how village adoption by a college could upgrade the ruralites' living conditions with active support through the NSS.

The first day's programme started with mushroom cultivation techniques along with audio-visual display and practical demonstration to the villagers by two resource persons of Digboi, Padma Borgohain and Nirmali Mech and was assisted by Deepanjol Borgohain, a student volunteer. After the technical programme, the mushroom seeds were distributed freely among the villagers.

On the following day, the village school education programme got off with morning prayers where all the 25 student volunteers took part and imparted lessons from 1st to 10th

standard during the stipulated periods for five days continuously.

It is worth mentioning that Saraipung LP School has only one teacher for five classes from Class-I to Class-V, while the nearest high school is about 8 kms away at Bhadoi Paanchali. The dropout ratio is high in the village.

A parallel session comprising free veterinary camp was also organised by the NSS unit and conducted by the Office of the District Animal Husbandry and Veterinary Office of Tinsukia for the domestic cattle of the villagers along with vaccination, treatment, medicines and castration. The veterinary team was led by Dr Marzina Khatoon, Dhurbajyoti Deb Laskar, Lalit Sonowal and Prasanta Hazarika. The villagers recalled that free veterinary camp was never arranged during

the last 20 years.

In the evening session, an awareness programme on 'Superstitious Beliefs and Anti-Witchcraft' was conducted by Kishor Haloi, Assistant Programme Officer of NSS Digboi College unit. On the third day, another free medical camp for the villagers was organised by the NSS unit and conducted by the Rotary Club of Duliajan with support from a doctors' team from Duliajan OIL Hospital.

Altogether, 244 patients were treated freely by five doctors, namely Dr AK Deka, Dr Raktim Borgohain, Dr Reshma Kamal, Dr Medhabrot Nirala and Dr Navneet Swargiari.

In the evening session, a cultural programme was conducted by the NSS student volunteers with various performances like Satriya Nritya, Bihu dance, Nepali dance, Assamese songs, remix, etc.

Digboi College, Mangaldai Civil Hospital observe World Blood Donor Day

DIBRUGARH, June 14: The National Service Scheme (NSS) of Digboi College unit in collaboration with the Red Ribbon Club of Digboi College, 26 Assam (I) COY, NCC Digboi College, Tinsukia Civil Hospital Blood Bank, Tinsukia, Digboi Community and Health Centre and Digboi College Students' Union observed the World Blood Donor Day 2017 at Digboi College campus in Tinsukia district today.

Dr Mridul Gogoi, senior medical officer of Tinsukia Civil Hospital Blood Bank delivered a lecture on the importance of blood donation while Dr Palash Dutta, senior surgeon of the same hospital and Dr D Dehingia of Digboi Community and Health Centre encouraged the audience for blood donations. Colonel S Shankar, of the 26 Assam (I) COY, NCC, Digboi, Subedar Vinod Kumar, Havildar Samarjeet Singh, Laskar Dilip Baruah of NCC cadets troop Digboi College rendered their support and assis-

tance for the said blood donation camp.

Altogether 31 blood donors including eight female volunteers donated their blood to the organisation through Tinsukia Civil Hospital Blood Bank. The first blood donor started with Dipesh Mondal, Assistant Professor of the Department of Bengali, Digboi College, a release stated.

Our Mangaldai Correspondent adds: Celebrating the birth anniversary of Austrian scientist Karl Landstein, the person who first distinguished blood groups, the World Blood Donors Day was observed here today along with the rest of the State.

In this connection a public awareness and felicitation function was organised by the Mangaldai Civil Hospital Blood Bank authority at the Sainik Bhawan premises. Addressing the function as the chief guest, Bidyut Bikash Bhagawati, ADC (Health), Darrang highlighted the significance of observing the day and said, "The

main focus of observing the day is to create awareness about voluntary blood donation."

Speaking on the occasion as the appointed speaker Dr PK Tahbikdar, pathologist and retired Joint Director of Health Services explained how the importance of voluntary blood donors gained up since 1998 after the apex court passed rul-

ing on discouraging commercial donors and emphasised on only voluntary donors. He lamented that Assam with an average achievement of 57 per cent voluntary donors is lagging far behind then the other States of the country including Tripura and West Bengal.

The meeting presided over by Dr Rama Kanta Bora, pres-


ident of Indian Medical Association, Darrang was also addressed by Dr Pranita Saikia, Joint Director of Health Services, Darrang, Dr Binita Goswami, Superintendent of Mangaldai Civil Hospital, Dr JM Kataki, Dr Munindra Medhi, Major Horiman Deka in-charge of NCC, Mangaldai College, Khanindra Rajbong-


shi, president, AASU, Darrang and voluntary blood donor Sekhar Mazumdar. Dr Daud Ali, in-charge medical officer, Blood Bank explained its objectives.


The meeting also witnessed felicitation to representatives of several local NGOs including Crystal Vision, Humanity, Marowari Yuva Mancha, Kharputia, Dogra Regiment, Deomornoi, Rising Hands, Tangla and Whats Up Blood Donation Group which contributed immensely in enriching the Mangaldai Blood Bank over the years.

The meeting was followed by a blood donation camp where a section of jawans of Army camp Deomornoi, students of GNM Training School Mangaldai and few local youths donated blood. Earlier, in the morning a rally was taken out through the Mangaldai town as a part of the celebration. The day was also marked with the presentation of several awareness street plays by the artistes of Crystal Vision, Mangaldai in all the block PHE areas of the district.

DIBRUGARH, Dec 7: The National Service Scheme (NSS) unit of Digboi College, as part of social responsibility programme, conducted a free health check-up camp and also carried out a socio-economic survey at Saraipung forest village under Saraipung Forest Range Office of Digboi Forest

from December 2 to 5.

The NSS unit, comprising students, initiated the programme at the remote village adjacent to Dehing Patkai Wildlife Sanctuary under the leadership of Rajib Rudra Tariang, Programme Officer, NSS Unit, Digboi College. Tariang is also the Assistance Profes-

sor of the Department of Zoology, Digboi College.

The team conducted the socio-economic survey in the village, which has 86 families.

During the survey, the students interacted with the villagers individually to know the problems in the area. The students reportedly were informed of various problems pertaining to drinking water,

using, education, BPL card, road communication, health centre, elephant and wild buffalo depredation, agricultural knowledge, etc.

The team has decided to make an intensive study of the village and their problems, analyse it and then write to various government agencies to provide services to the society without bias as early as pos-

sible, a release informed.

The NSS unit of Digboi College also organised a free health check-up camp in the LP School Campus of the Saraipung forest village, on December 4.


Dr Babul Hussain and Dr Dipen Borthakur examined the villagers.


Dipankar Singha, a well-wisher, and three ex-students – Deepndu Karmakar, Tribeed Diwanjee, and Kunal Dutta – helped the villagers with free medicine supply while some other medicines were purchased by Digboi College.


A few members of Aaranyak and students of Wildlife Conservation Biology, Digboi College also helped for the success of the programme.



Digboi College reaches out to flood victims

DIBRUGARH, Aug 26: The National Service Scheme (NSS) of Digboi College unit initiated the post-flood relief programme and distributed some essential materials to the flood-affected victims of the Sumoni Gaon, near Bordhirak of Kakopathar under Doomdoma Circle of the Tinsukia district, one of the worst-affected villages of the circle.

This programme was jointly conducted by the NSS, Digboi College unit, the teachers and staff of Digboi College and the

26 Assam (Independent) COY, NCC of Digboi College wing on August 23, a release stated.

Altogether 222 individuals of 46 families with 60 school children and 90 females benefited from the post-flood relief materials. The relief materials included rice, flattened rice, pulse, sugar, oil, milk, horlicks, biscuits, mineral water, candles, soaps, bleaching power, mosquito coil, disinfectants, school copies and books, school bags and related materials (pencil box, pencils, pens, rubber, sharpeners), bed-sheets, clothes, diapers. Other essential items for the 90 fe-


male victims were also distributed separately.

Rajib Rudra Tariang, programme officer, NSS, Digboi College unit and assistant professor in the Department of Zoology of Digboi College addressed the villagers of the Sumoni Gaon in the premises of the Sumoni LP School. Gaon Bura Tileswar Moran and M Raha, Latmondal of the Doomdoma Revenue Circle Office also addressed the villagers before the flood relief materials were distributed.

Altogether 23 NSS volunteers led by the Programme

Officer, 13 NCC cadets led by Samerjit Singh, Havildar of the 26 Assam (I) COY, NCC, 13 teachers – Tariang, PK Khound, Dr PK Bharati, Dr J Lohkar, Dipesh Mondol, Gauri Buragohain, Dr Kanchan Konwar, Jitu Borah, Subhasish Gogoi, Dr Sangeeta Saikia Baruah, Dr Mamoni Sarma Borthakur, Dr Itu Das and Dr Anamika Neog besides four non-teaching staff along with two police personnel of the Kakopathar Police Station volunteered for the distribution of the post-flood relief materials.


