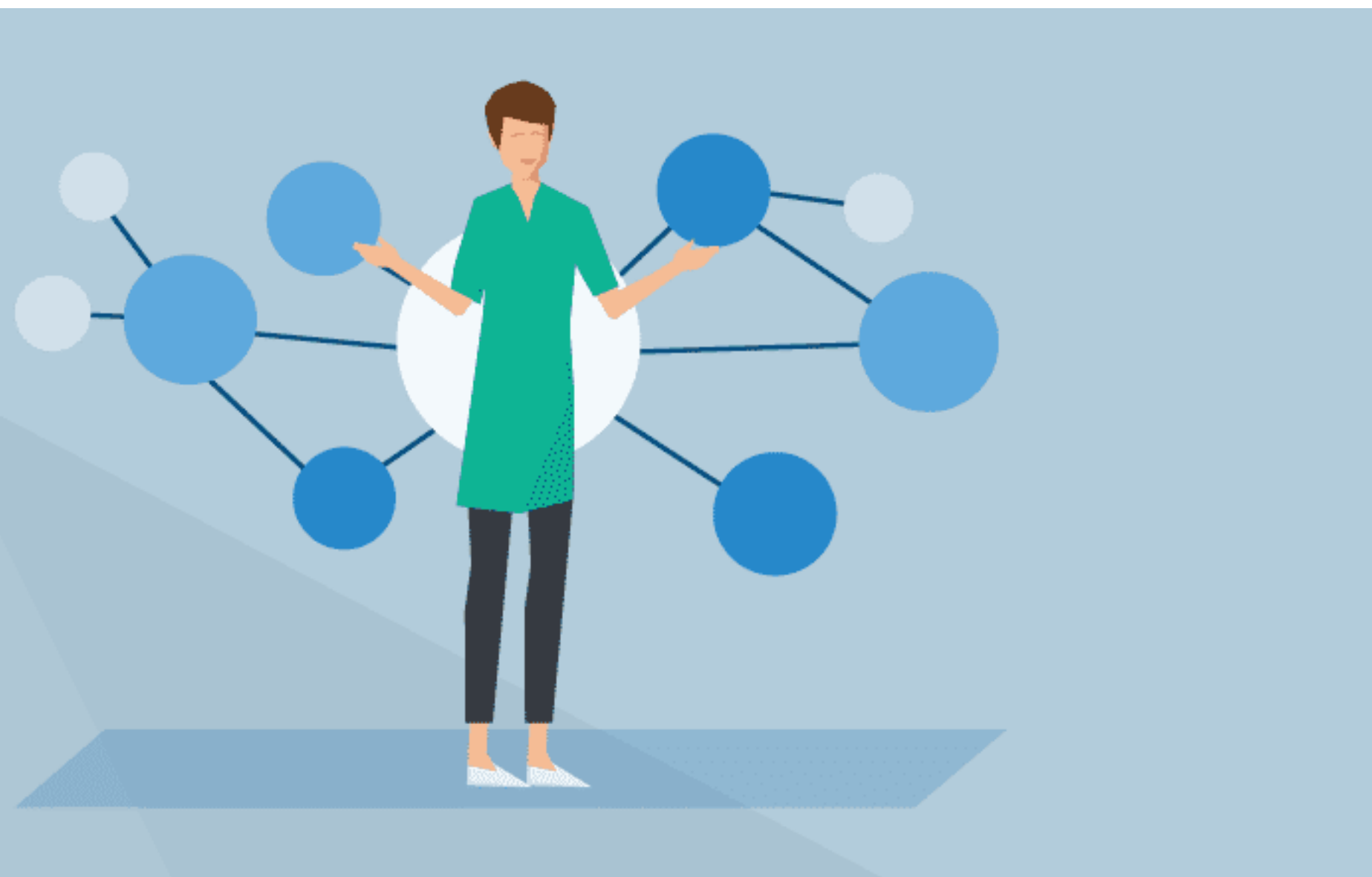

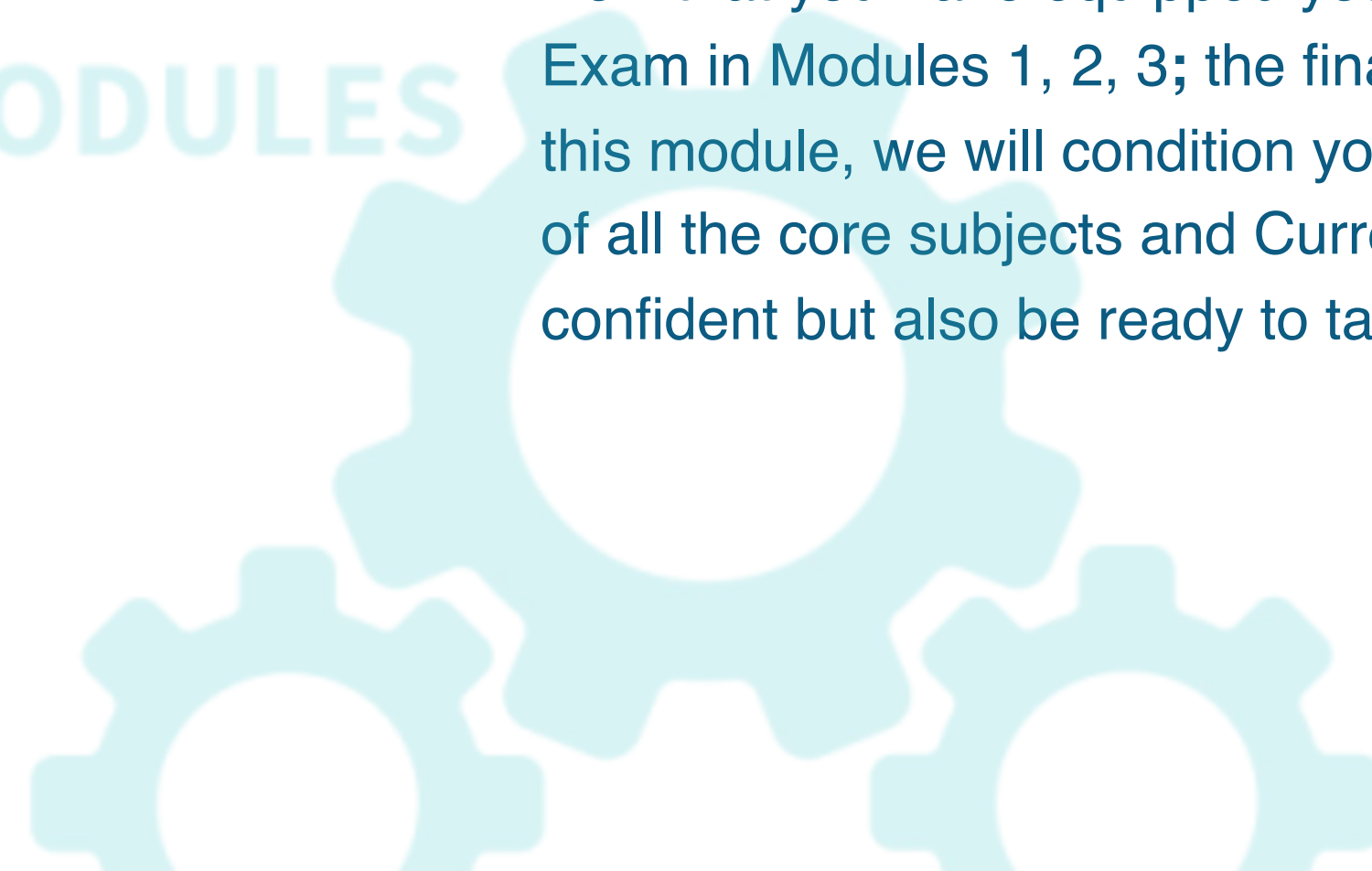

## 02. NUMBER OF TESTS AND FREQUENCY

**52 General Studies (Paper 1) Tests + 10 CSAT (Paper 2) Tests.** Out of 62 Tests, 42 tests (32 GS + 10 CSAT) are full length (100 Questions) & 20 Current Affairs Tests with 50 Questions per Test.

The Tests on Core Subjects are held every 10 Days and Current Affairs Tests are held every 15 days.

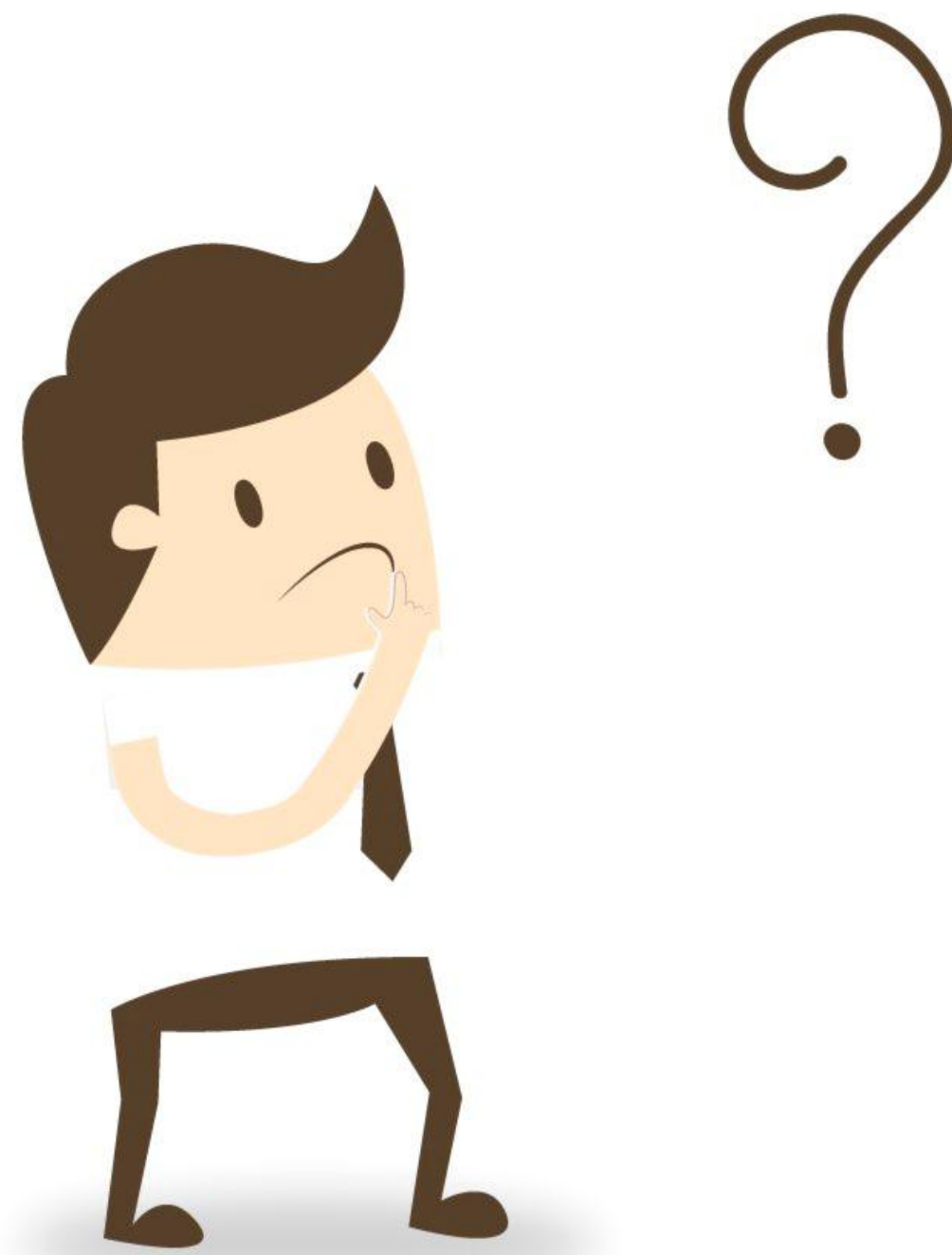

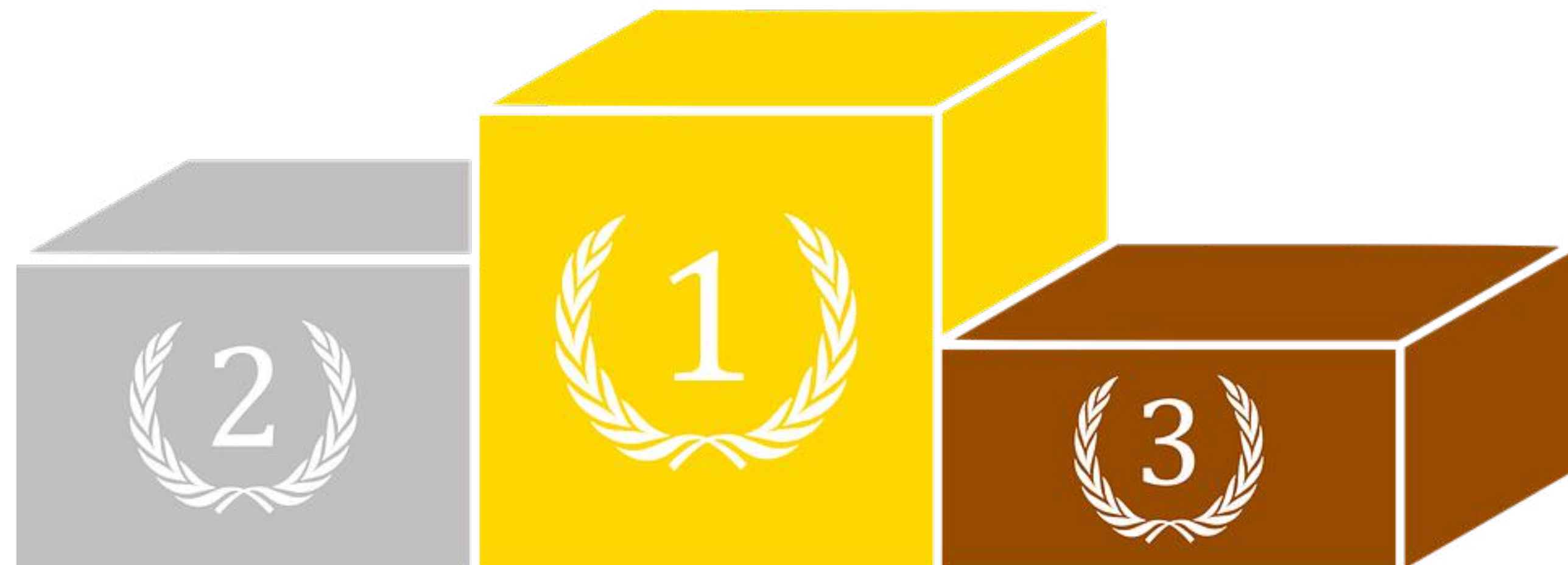
