

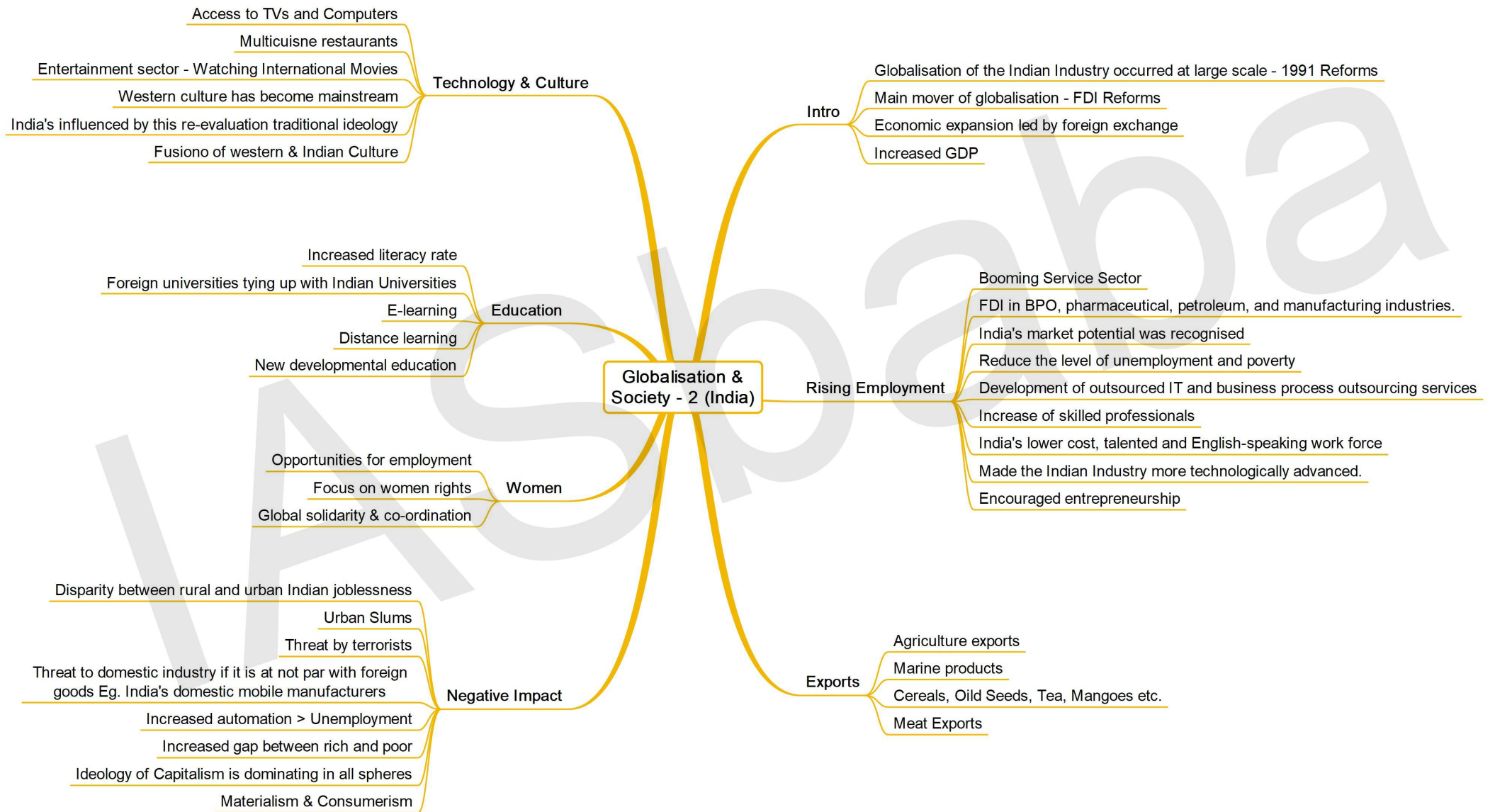
## Globalisation & Society - 1

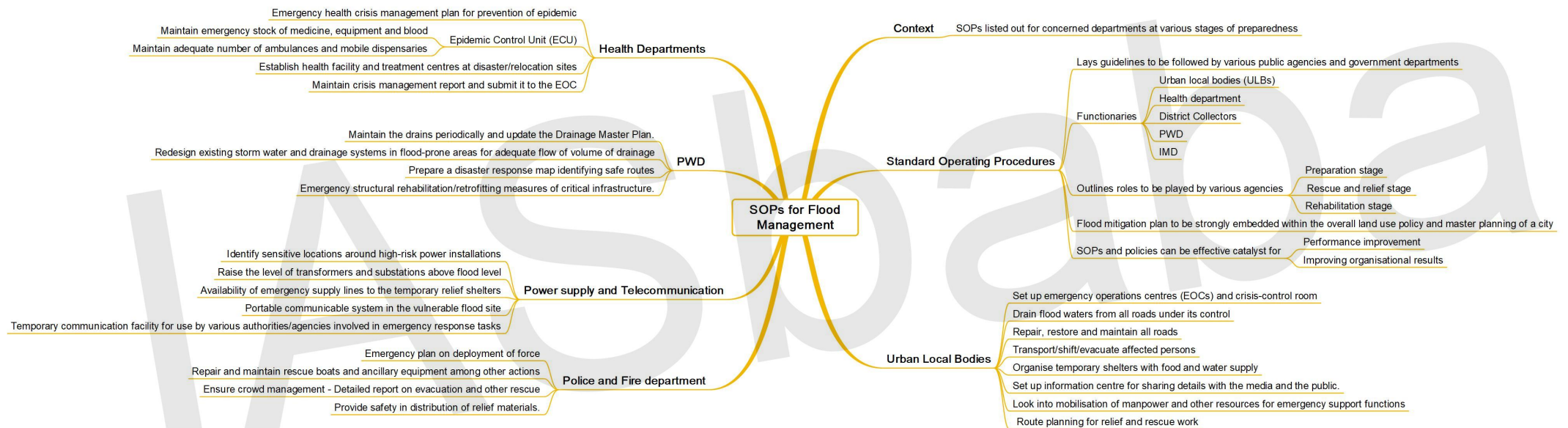
### Cons

- Inequality still exists
- Digital divide
- Spread of communicable diseases
- Global recession impacts nations in particular too
- Too much dependence on global value chains
- Have somewhat restricted 'Self Reliance' of a country
- Jobless Growth
- Developed Countries are benefitted most
- Westernisation (Not necessarily modernisation)
- Threat to traditional knowledge
- Heavy migration towards certain countries & urban areas
- Xenophobia led due to migration
- Illegal migration
- Communal Violence & Social Tensions -Eg. Sweden Riots
- Materialism & Communalism
- Disparity between rural and urban Indian joblessness
- Rise in urban slums
- Rise in Terrorist Activities
- Can adversely impact domestic industries
- Increasing unemployment in developing countries due to heavy production of same products in developed countries
