They haven't been used in vaccine development and nitrification as yet.

Conservationists say the invasive weed has a negative effect on local biodiversity, crowding out native species and limiting food availability for wildlife. Senna spectabilis, along with Lantana camara, is among five major invasive weeds that had taken over vast swathes of the Nilgiris, with wattle being the other major invasive species.

The interaction could lead to changes in the track and intensity of either or both storms systems. In rare cases, the two systems could merge, especially when they are of similar size and intensity, to form a bigger storm.
